

# WELCOME TO WOODHOUSE

## Site Rules

Our aim here at Woodhouse Farm is to ensure your visit is safe and enjoyable and if you require any help or information we are here to help. Our rules outlined below are in place for the benefit of all our customers.

All new arrivals and visitors **must** report to reception on arrival.

Commercial vehicles strictly not admitted. No private generators are to be used on the park.

Single sex parties and group bookings are only admitted by prior arrangement, a bond may be asked for.

Every effort is made to accommodate you on a particular pitch if requested, but this cannot be guaranteed.

Caravanners and campers are responsible for keeping their pitch areas clean and tidy.

At busy times pitches must be vacated by 12 noon, but by 5pm at other times.

Pitches are only available from 1pm on the day of arrival.

Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a short lead at all times except in the dog exercise field. No fouling of the park will be tolerated as bins are provided. Dogs must not be left unattended in your unit or on the park. Neither are they allowed to 'hunt' on or around the lake or woods.

Only one car per pitch is allowed. Extra cars must be parked on the car park.

The speed limit around the park is 10mph.

Please do not drive around the park between the hours of 11pm and 8 am. If you are out until late or leaving early then please leave your car on the car park.

Barbeques are allowed but they must be raised off the ground and should not damage grass. Blocks are available if required.

The lighting of fires anywhere on the park and the use of metal detectors and firearms are strictly forbidden.

Abuse or damage to the toilet blocks or games room will be considered a serious offence.

Please do not cross the site boundaries.

Laundry and pot washing must not take place in the toilets/showers, as there are facilities for this on site. Washing may only be hung from a window drying rack and should be unobtrusive.

Between the hours of 10 pm and 8 am, **please be quiet**.

The shop is open daily, please check for opening times and respect these.

The above conditions are in place for the benefit of all our customers. Any persons who are not prepared to abide by them will be asked to leave and acceptance of these conditions are taken when booking at reception.
