

WELCOME TO WOODHOUSE

Site Rules

Our aim here at Woodhouse Farm is to ensure your visit is safe and enjoyable and if you require any help or information we are here to help. Our rules outlined below are in place for the benefit of all our customers.

All new arrivals and visitors **must** report to reception.

Commercial vehicles strictly not admitted. No private generators are to be used on the park. Single sex parties and group bookings are not accepted. PLEASE ALSO NOTE, GAZEBOS, DAY TENTS AND THE LIKE ARE NOT PERMITTED.

Every effort is made to accommodate you on a particular pitch if requested, but this cannot be guaranteed.

Caravanners and campers are responsible for keeping their pitch areas clean and tidy.

Pitches are only available from 1pm on the day of arrival and must be vacated by 12 noon on the day of departures unless otherwise arranged.

Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a short lead at all times except in the dog exercise field. No fouling of the park will be tolerated as bins are provided. Dogs must not be left unattended in your unit or on the park. Neither are they allowed to "hunt" around the lake or wood.

Only one car per pitch is allowed. Extra cars must be parked on the car park (charges apply). The speed limit around the park is 5mph. Please ensure that you observe the speed limit. **Pedestrians have right of way**

Please do not drive around the park between the hours of 10pm and 8am. In consideration to other customers excessive noise and loud music is not acceptable within these hours. Lighting is kept to a minimum around the park and the use of a torch is advisable after dusk.

The lighting of fires anywhere on the park and the use of metal detectors and firearms is strictly forbidden. BB Guns, water pistols and water bombs are not allowed.

Abuse or damage to the toilet blocks, games room or play equipment will be considered a serious offence. Please ensure young children are supervised when using the toilet blocks. Please do not cross the site boundaries.

Laundering and pot washing must not take place in the toilets/showers, as there are facilities for this on site. Washing may only be hung from a window drying rack and should be unobtrusive.

Rubbish should be put in the big bins and not left outside to encourage wasps and look unsightly. Our bins are for rubbish only; any electrical, household or large items must not be put in them, but taken to the recycling centre in Ripon. Please help us by recycling wherever possible as adequate bins are provided around the park

Barbecues are allowed but they must be raised off the ground and should not be damage the grass. Blocks are available if required. Cycling around the park is allowed but children should not cycle in and around other customer's pitches, cars or the toilet block.

If you are having visitors whilst staying with us then please inform the park prior to their arrival. All visitors' cars must remain on the car park (charges apply) and they are requested to be off the park by 9pm.

Access onto the park is via a barrier system. This barrier only operates between the hours of 7:30am and 11:30pm. All customers are provided with their own access code which is NOT transferable.

The shop is open daily, please check for opening times and respect these.

Any persons who are not prepared to abide by these rules will be asked to leave. Acceptance of these conditions is taken when booking in at reception.
